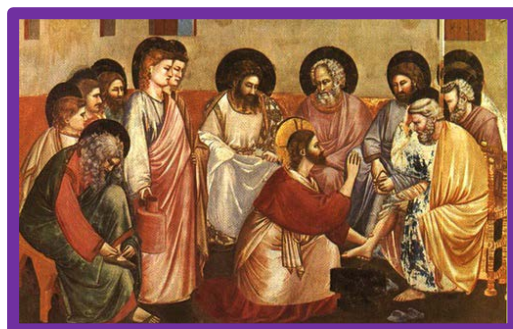

Due to the Parents Evening, there will not be any After School Clubs on Thursday. They will resume the week after half term.

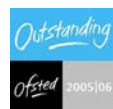
School Nurse

School Fund

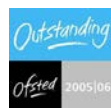
