Armistice Day

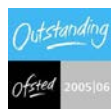
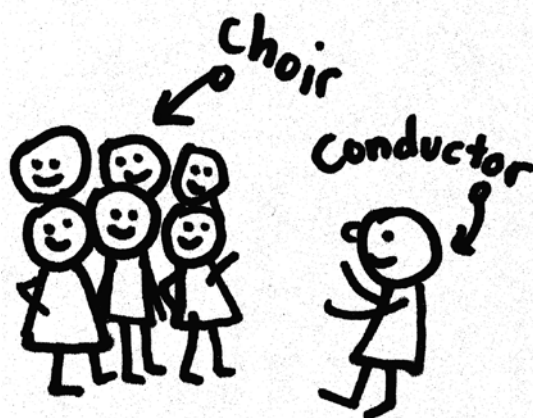

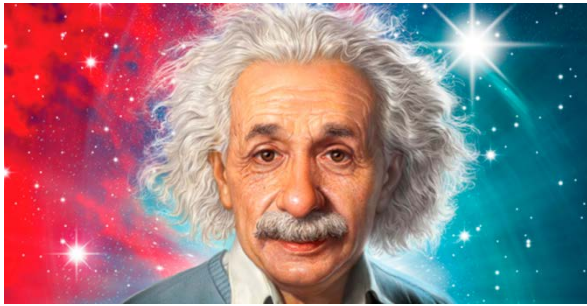
Parents Christmas Choir

Anti-Bullying Week

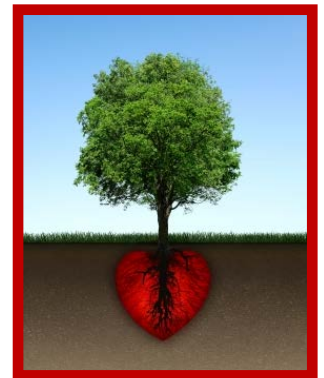
National Anti-Bullying week will be taking place next week, please keep an eye out for the activities taking place.
