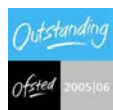

1. Go to tesco.com/ues.
2. Select 'Newham' from the Local Education Authority tab.
3. Select St. Winefride's from the School tab.
4. Choose which items you would like and order them!
5. Wait just under 14 days and they will be with you!
