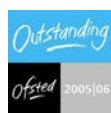
Choir News and Events

Well, where do we begin? Last Friday our choir, as part of the Commonwealth Youth Choir, attended a special recording session, with the Coldstream Guards, at RAF Northolt. They were there to record a special song that will be played to Her Majesty, Queen Elizabeth II on her birthday. While they were there they had a photo taken in front of an iconic 'Spitfire' fighter plane and this picture will now be used in the official Coldstream Guards brochure for the coming year.



Furthermore Major Simon Haw, the director of music for the Band of the Coldstream Guards, Corps of Army Music was so impressed by the children that he has asked for them to be part of many exciting events during the next few months and has 'adopted' them as the official children's choir of the Coldstream Guards. 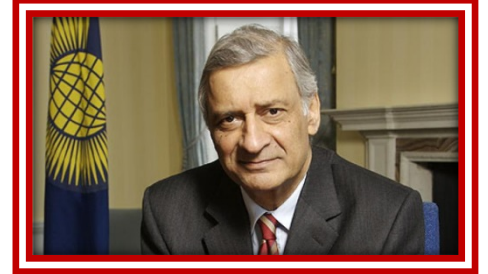

Just in time for Easter our Living Eggs have arrived in school. The eggs have hatched already and the children have been able to witness the speed at which the chicks grow.



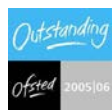
Cycle Confident Training

This Week's Prayer

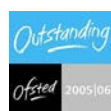
Every week we put a prayer in the newsletter, related to the week's Gospel. Please say the prayer with your children.
