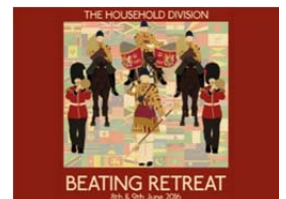
### Generic Slips Etc.
