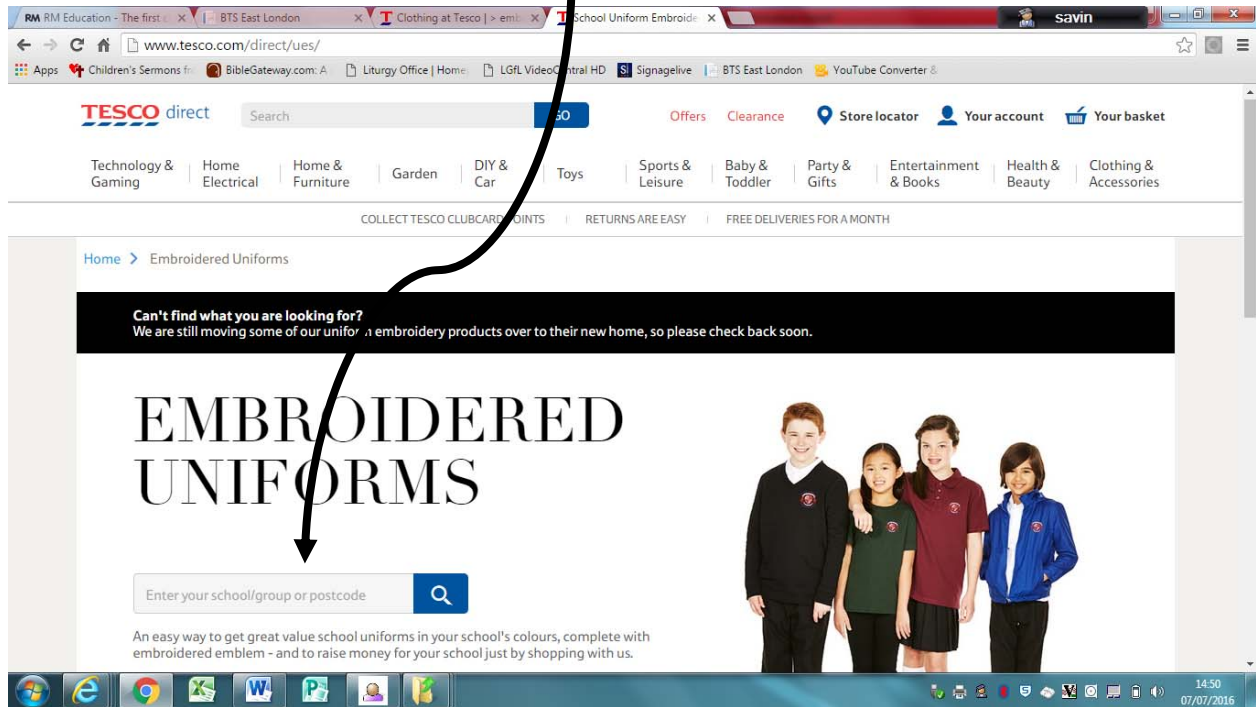

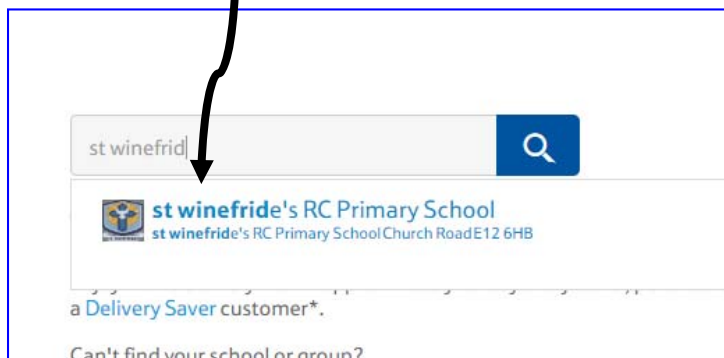
School Uniform
