<b>Friday 17 February</b>	11am - 1pm	<p><b>Ferret and fluffy Friday</b> - Come and meet all of the fluffy animals that live at the farm. Play with our fun ferrets and cuddle up to our fluffy bunny rabbits. Open to all ages.</p>
