
## Dates for your Diary

## Data from the Fischer Family Trust



For the next few weeks we will be publishing data from the Fischer Family Trust, an organisation that analyses data and results from every school in the country. The chart on the left is called a 'dashboard' and the further to the right the arrows point the better the

results and valued added (this means have the school helped the children achieve as much as they should have in relation to earlier tests and evaluations.) In our case we are 'significantly above the national average' in every measure! More to follow next week!
