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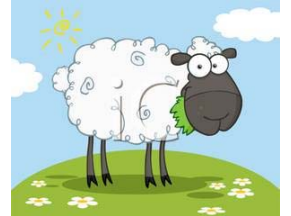

The Lost Sheep

This week the Gospel tells us how God welcomes everyone into His Kingdom, no matter how they behave during their lives, so long as they truly repent. In a similar way we always give children another chance to make the correct decisions, if they are having a difficult day. We have adapted our behaviour system to give the children more chances of moving their names up the chart and also giving them plenty of opportunities to amend any poor behaviour. For example now a whole class may be moved up a level if the teacher feels that a lesson has gone exceptionally well and if a child is unfortunately moved to the Orange Zone they will be given a chance to reflect and write down their thoughts to enable them to begin to move back up the chart. We hope these changes will lead to many more children receiving Gold Letters and far fewer being 'stuck in Green'.

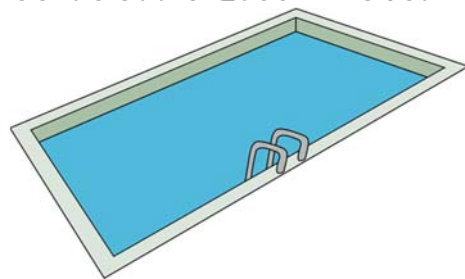


Osmington Bay

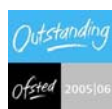
Dear Father,

ST. WINEFRIDE'S CATHOLIC PRIMARY SCHOOL - UNIFORM LIST

The Governors of the school have decided that: -

1. The school uniform should be universal; i.e. that it should be worn by all children in the school.
2. That the school uniform shall consist of the following and is available to order online, unless stated otherwise, at the address below:
 - Black trousers, knee length skirt or tunic
 - White shirt/blouse
 - Blue jumper or cardigan with the school logo
 - Blue and yellow striped tie (**available from school office**)
 - Plain black low heeled shoes
 - White socks; Black Tights (Girls) Black socks (Boys)

Note: Socks are not to be worn over the knee

- The only items of jewellery allowed are small stud earrings and discreet crosses on chains. No other type of jewellery is allowed
- All jewellery must be removed before taking part in PE lessons, both indoor and outdoor, during before and after school sports clubs and when attending swimming lessons
- PE Kit: Black shorts or jogging pants, white T-Shirt with school logo and black plimsolls for indoor PE. Black trainers may be worn for outdoor PE.
- No brightly coloured trainers are to be worn in school. No studded/bladed footwear is to be worn in school

In summer: Optional

Girls: Light sky blue check dress, or black skirt and white polo shirt with school logo both to be worn with white socks.

Boys: Black shorts and white polo shirt with school logo, worn with black or grey socks.

If wearing the summer uniform a tie is not required to be worn. If a plain white shirt/blouse is worn then a tie **MUST** be worn too.

Before applying for admission to the school, parents/carers are asked to consider their responsibilities in terms of school uniform and support the governors' decision in this respect. Any child not wearing the correct uniform will be given a letter to take home to their parent/carer providing details of the incorrect uniform.
