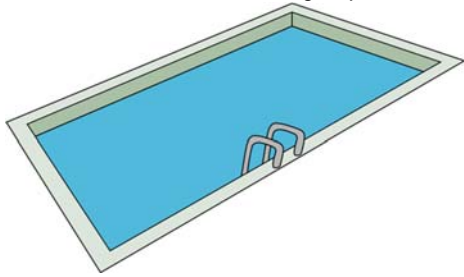

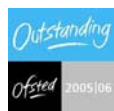


## Book Corner Competition

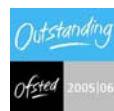
