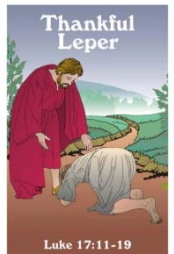

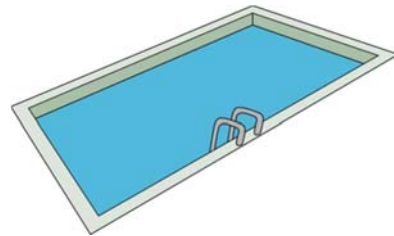

Choir at Australia House

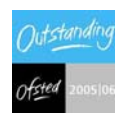

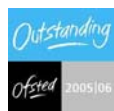
Parkrun

Today we have had both a traditional African storyteller and also an African Drumming session for the children. Both sessions were fantastic, even if one was slightly noisier than the other!

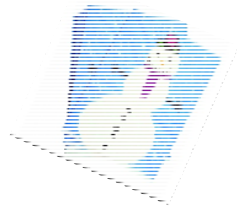


Mini Reports and Parents Evening

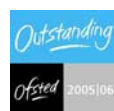


This Week's Prayer
