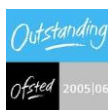

Safeguarding Updates

Resulting from a Safeguarding Audit on Friday 24th March, the following changes in practice will take place immediately:

1. The School is a mobile free zone, the use of mobile phones is forbidden in all areas of the school that are accessible to children, *including the playground*. Mobile phones brought into school by the children **MUST** be kept in the School Office.
2. All visitors must sign in at the School Office. Parents attending the Friday Coffee Morning must collect a visitor pass from the School Office.
3. The document '[Keeping Children Safe in Education](#)' will be available in the School Office and also in the waiting area for all parents and visitors to read.

Please do not take offence if you are asked to refrain from using your mobile phone in the school building or playground. This is an over arching rule that everyone, from the Headteacher to any visitor, must abide by, for the safety of the children.

Communion Classes

The Communion Classes are well underway. We recognise that if you have to collect more than one child that it is impracticable to go home and return less than 30 minutes later, so if you have a child in the Communion Classes, you may wait in the Infant Corridor with your other children until the lessons are over. **However, under no circumstances may food be eaten in this corridor while you are waiting for your children. Please be considerate and refrain from bringing 'take away food' into school to consume while you are waiting.**

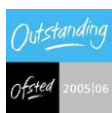
This week, we are looking at:

Question 9. 'The school is well led and managed.'

All respondents agreed that the school is well led and managed. This is obviously a very pleasing result for the SLT and the Governing Body.

Question 10. 'The school responds well to any concerns raised.'

Another very high approval rate of 98% shows that the school does indeed respond well to any concerns raised. It may be surmised that the four 'Don't Know' replies have not, as yet, had to raise any such concerns. However two parents were of the opinion that their concerns were not responded to well, unfortunately as the replies were anonymous it is very difficult for the school to be able to react and ensure that these concerns are now responded to in the manner the parents would like. Efforts will be made to ensure that all concerns raised by parents are dealt with effectively and to the satisfaction of all concerned.
