
may annoy us from time to time, God has given us the wisdom to forgive and we should make the most of this gift at all times.



Percentage of pupils achieving at a higher standard in reading, writing and maths


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Average score in reading

This score shows how well pupils performed in the [key stage 2](#) reading test.


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Average score in maths
