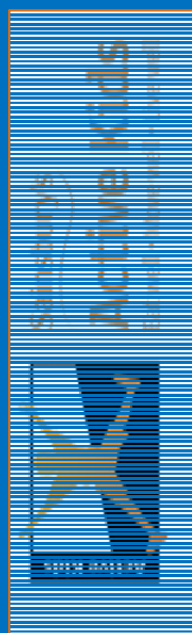

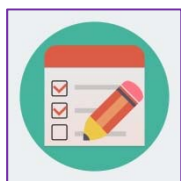
good things! During this season of Lent, do the right thing for the right reason.

Question 3: 'My child is making good progress at school' - While 97% of parents thought that their child is making good progress, one parent disagreed and a further two did not know. The SLT are going to investigate whether the termly school reports may need adjusting to show children's progress even more clearly than they do at the present.

Question 4: 'My child is well looked after' - For this question 99% of parents considered that their child was well looked after. The one response which disagreed noted that there had been 'a few incidents...during playtime.'
