Archery is cancelled this week as Mr Savin will not be in on Friday.



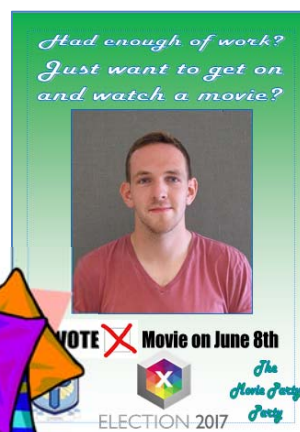
Fete Tickets on sale NOW!

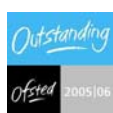


Admin Reminder
