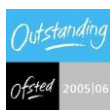
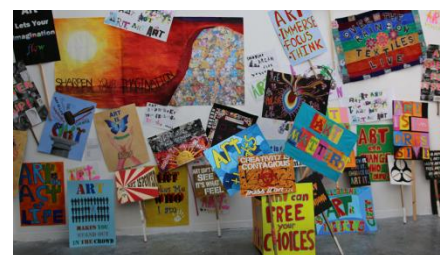


If you would like to come in to school to tell the children all about your home country, please contact the School Office at the number above. If you would like to talk about one of the home countries that would also be very much welcomed!
