Free School Meals

Following the letter sent out to all of the parent/carers earlier this week we would like to remind you that it is **Absolutely Vital** that you take the time to go to the following link: <https://pps.lgfl.org.uk> to see if you do qualify for Free School Meals (FSM). If you do not qualify you WILL have to pay for your children's meals from September, if they are in Year 3 or above. You only have to register once and it will cover your child for their entire time at St Winefride's (it lasts roughly five or six years but is liable to change) so it is well worth doing. We also receive extra funding called Pupil Premium, which may only be spent on those children who qualify for it, so the more applicants the better for both you financially and the children.
