## This Week's Gospel (Matthew 22:1-14)

Jesus told the parable of the wedding banquet to show the people that God has invited everyone to His kingdom yet only a few will actually be chosen to enter. This reminds us that it is our actions not our words that are important. The parable explains how those that the king thought were friends were not interested in attending his child's wedding banquet and in the end random people from the street were chosen to come and enjoy the feast instead. This in many ways would be a good place to leave the story, the rich and wealthy rejecting a request and the poor humbly accepting it. However, Jesus then goes on to tell us how one of the guests insulted his host by not dressing appropriately. It may seem a small point but it shows that everyone is invited to the Kingdom of God, but not everyone will be allowed to enter. The rich and wealthy simply did not bother to accept the invite, while the rude guest accepted the invitation yet did not behave accordingly.
