## This Week's Gospel (Matthew 25:14-30)

The Gospel this week told us the Parable of the Gold Bags (or Talents). Although the story is literally about servants taking gold and making more of it for their master, or not in the case of the frightened servant, this is not what Jesus was trying to tell the people. Jesus was telling us that God has given each of us a talent: be it the ability to run fast like Usain Bolt; paint like Leonardo da Vinci or be kind like the children in Class 1D showed in their assembly a couple of weeks ago, and we must use this talent and not bury it like the frightened servant.
