AGREEMENT

1. The values taught by Jesus Christ are always at the heart of our community.
2. We will provide a broad and balanced curriculum which will support their learning according to their needs. Every child will be helped to grow in knowledge, skills attitudes and understanding.
3. Racial and cultural diversity will be valued in our school. The partnership between school, home and parish will be developed and celebrated.
4. We will provide regular homework where appropriate to support our childrens' learning.
5. Parents will be entitled to have access to the staff at appropriate times to discuss their child's progress.
6. Teachers will communicate to parents regularly through our communication books, particularly if there are any notable positive or negative comments to make.
7. Every effort will be made to meet each child's educational needs.
8. Based upon Christian values, we expect child to be polite and respectful. Persistent behaviour that shows disrespect or aggression will result in withdrawal and may lead to exclusion.
9. Good work and behaviour will always be rewarded.
10. A regular system of recording each child's progress and achievement will be maintained and parents will be permitted access to these records.
11. Parents will be kept informed of items of interest in the life of the school.
12. We will work alongside the parish in the spiritual development of the children and the understanding of our faith.
13. The Governing Body actively supports the work of the school.
14. We have a very supportive and active parents association known as the Friends of St.Winefride's. The school is very committed to the work of the Friends and will do all it can to ensure it's continued success.

THE PARENT'S AGREEMENT

As parents accepting a place at St. Winefride's Catholic Primary School we will ensure that she/he grows up practising the Catholic Faith.

1. Our family will continue to play our part within the parish community.
2. Our child is aware of the need to observe the school rules.
3. We will ensure that our child wears the correct uniform and leaves all jewellery at home
4. We will ensure that all items of clothing are marked with our child's name.
5. We will ensure that our child attends school regularly and we will provide a written note outlining reasons for absence on return from leave outside of school holiday dates.
6. We will make every effort to ensure that our child is punctual at the beginning of the day and is collected promptly at the end of the day.
7. We will help our child to complete any homework task that is set.
8. We will get involved in school life and support the activities of the Friends of St. Winefride's Association.
9. We will immediately inform the school of any changes to our address, telephone number and emergency contact details.
10. We will make every effort to attend parental meetings/parent days.
11. We understand that late nights and lack of sleep will hamper our child's progress and will see that she/he is in bed at a reasonable time.
12. We know that unsupervised television viewing can be very damaging to our child's emotional development and we undertake to monitor this.
13. We understand that the cost of external maintenance and repairs has to be met from the Governor's Fund and understand that the school is obliged to seek contributions from parents.
14. If there are any problems in school we will support joint action with the school and work together to overcome these difficulties. Under no circumstances will we confront another child regarding a school issue.
15. If our child is responsible for any wilful damage or loss of any school property, we will ensure that is repaired or replaced.
16. We understand that all items of uniform or equipment brought into school are the responsibility of our child and the school cannot be held liable for any loss or damage.
17. We are committed to our child's education at St. Winefride's and will do all that we can to ensure it is a worthwhile experience.
