

# A Catholic Education for your child?

Many parents think that a Catholic Education is about sending their child to a Catholic School, and that certainly is what is on offer to Catholic Parents in Newham, where we have seven Primary schools and two secondary schools, but a Catholic education begins with the desire of the Parents to share their faith with their children. This brochure has been put together by the Catholic Parishes and Schools of Newham to help you understand your role, the role of your parish and the role of the school. It is a combined task, you are not on your own, the parish and school are there to assist you on the journey, but the journey begins in the home, and begins when you bring your child to be baptised.

### The Family | Baptism

"You have asked to have your child baptised. In doing so you are accepting the responsibility of training him/her in the practice of the faith. It will be your duty to bring him/her up to keep God's commandments as Christ taught us, by loving God and our neighbour. Do you clearly understand what you are undertaking?" At your child's Baptism, these words were addressed to you by the priest, and you answered, "We do" for the first people responsible for educating a child in the faith are their parents. "Catholic parents learn to form their family as a 'domestic church,' a church in the home as it were. where God is honoured prayer is a normal event ... and everyone shares the hopes, the problems, and sufferings of everyone else." St John Paul II

The "domestic church" - is where children learn from watching their Father and Mother how to love God. In a word, your children will learn from you how to live a Christian life; you will be their first teachers in the faith, the faith is passed on 'around the family table,' in ordinary conversation, in the language that persevering love alone knows how to speak.

This is the building block on which a child begins to know about the things of God, and as they grow this strong foundation opens them to the wisdom of faith that enables them to navigate the ups and downs of daily life. This may seem daunting, but your local parish and school are here to help you.



## The Parish "It takes a whole village to bring up a child"

This wise African saying helps us to understand the importance of being part of our local parish, for it is here that by example, encouragement, teaching, and belonging to a community, that the roots of faith, sown at home, are strengthened. It is in the Parish those parents are given the support, and encouragement in their desire to bring up their children in the faith.

Catholic means universal, it is open to all. Many of you will have moved into your parish from other parts of the world, and one of your priorities has been to find the local Church. It is the "local" place for us wherever we may be in the world. The Parish is the point of gathering for those who believe in Jesus Christ, the place where we hear the Word of God, and receive the sacraments.




